The Central City Board of Education met at 12:00 p.m., on Tuesday, June 9, 2026 at the HS Conference Room 1510 28th Street in Central City, NE 68826.

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll call showed the following members present: Aaron Heins, Chuck Homolka, Brent Kennedy, Lisa Wagner, and Bret Zikmund. Also present: Jeff Jensen, Superintendent; Absent: Brian Buhlke.

It was moved by Homolka, seconded by Kennedy, that it is hereby determined that this meeting was preceded by advanced publicized notice by posting notices at the Superintendent's Office, Merrick County Courthouse and City Hall Office and is hereby declared to be duly convened in open session and a copy of the agenda is posted in the Superintendent's Office. Motion carried 5-0. Ayes: Heins, Homolka, Kennedy, Wagner, and Zikmund. Nays: None. Absent: Buhlke.

It was moved by Kennedy, seconded by Zikmund, to approve the agenda of the meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Ayes: Heins, Homolka, Kennedy, Wagner, and Zikmund. Nays: None. Absent: Buhlke.

It was moved with reservation by Heins, seconded by Zikmund, with reservation, to approve the settlement between the County of Merrick, NE and Green Plains Central City, LLC resulting in the repayment of \$337, 824.56 from the General Fund, \$21,281.60 from the Sinking Fund, \$15,534.81 from the Bond Fund, and \$4,612.90 from the QCPUF Fund (no longer taxed) through May collection balance at the County Treasurer's office to Green Plains Central City, LLC. Total settlement of \$382,571.49 from the General Fund, \$24,755.81 from the Sinking Fund, \$18,276.54 from the Bond Fund, and \$4,612.90 from the QCPUF Fund (no longer taxed) to Green Plains Central City, LLC. Green Plains Central City, LLC settled with the County of Merrick their assessed valuation for the tax years of 2021 through 2025 resulting in repayment. Motion Carried 4-1. Ayes: Heins, Homolka, Wagner, and Zikmund. Nays: Kennedy. Absent: Buhlke.
