What's Happening in the Classroom...

READING: We will continue instruction in the Reading Mastery program. Each group will move at a pace that is best for their learning! Most groups will complete a lesson and a worksheet daily. Ask your child about the sound that they trace on their worksheet! We will also be utilizing the Heggerty Phonemic Awareness program.

SCIENCE: We have finished our Forces and Motion unit and the book is your child's to keep! We will be spending this time creating Grandparents Day projects and reading stories/completing activities from the Food Group stories.

MATH: We will explore how to represent, count, and compare numbers 6-10. (addressing MA K.K.2.a I will use one-to-one correspondence when counting objects and understand the last number counted is the total and MA K.N.2.g I will identify numbers 0-20.)

HANDWRITING: We will be writing letters Z H K L U V W X Y.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We have finished our Being a Good Citizen unit (how we carry ourselves to be positive members of our community). The Being a Good Citizen book is your child's to keep! We will be using this time to do read alouds, while we eat our snacks.

PBiS: We will continue learning about our behavior expectations, rules, and procedures for being in school (in and out of the classroom).
