What We Are Learning

<u>Math</u>- We will spend this month finishing our perimeter unit before we move into our measurement unit. Concepts learned in our measurement unit will include metric and standard units. We will focus heavily on length, liquid capacity, mass, and weight. We will also spend a great deal of time learning about elapsed time.

<u>Reading/Writing</u>- We will start off the month of March by learning the many characteristics of fairy tales and reading some fairy tales unfamiliar to most of us. We will then review argumentative texts and how to best identify the author's perspective and point of view on different topics.

<u>Grammar/Spelling</u>- We will wrapping up our unit on pronouns at the beginning of this month. We will then take a little time to review the difference between contractions and possessive nouns, before we start our unit on adjectives.
